



MATS Downtime / Deviation Reporting Revisions Webinar December 15, 2020

How Do I Report Downtime under the Recent MATS Rule Revisions?

As part of the MATS electronic reporting revisions that were finalized in September, EPA changed the way monitor downtime is treated under the rule. Sources have always been required to operate and maintain the monitoring equipment needed to demonstrate compliance, but an infrequent malfunction or out-of-control period was not considered to be a failure to meet the obligation to monitor emissions. Now, any downtime associated with a malfunction and out-of-control period is considered a deviation. These changes are effective now and affect the upcoming semi-annual reporting that will soon be due for the current reporting period. This webinar will discuss the changes to the rule affecting monitor downtime, how such information needs to be reported, and potential ways of minimizing the impact of these changes.
